Dr. Howard Leyton-Brown studied in Europe with two of the most respected violin teachers of the twentieth century. After some years in England, where he served as concertmaster of the London Philharmonic Orchestra, he relocated his family to Canada, and settled in Regina. As well as pursuing a solo career, he served, at various times, as Director of the Regina Conservatory of Music, Saskatchewan Director of the Western Board of Music, conductor of the Regina Symphony Orchestra, concertmaster of that orchestra, and Head of the Department of Music at the University of Regina. He is now Professor Emeritus of Music, and still teaching violin.
